Brian has been a strong advocate for veterans and the local community through Post 3's holiday meals program and monthly breakfasts. For several years Brian has been a lead member of the Legion's Holiday Meals program, and instrumental in recruiting volunteers to work in the kitchen. As the Commander of the Sons of the American Legion for Post 3, he instigated the monthly Sunday Veterans' breakfasts. Let's rally together to support him and others in need!

Becoming a bone marrow donor is a noble endeavor that can save lives. Here's a concise guide on how to become a donor using the Be The Match website (https://bethematch.org):

- 1. Sign Up: Visit the Be The Match website and sign up to join the bone marrow registry. You'll answer a few questions about your medical history to determine if you're a good fit.
- 2. Receive a Swab Kit: After signing up, you'll receive a free cheek swab kit by mail within 3-7 business days. Follow the instructions to swab your cheek and send it back.
- 3. Genetic Typing: Your sample will be tested, and your genetic type will be added to the National Marrow Donor Program (NMDP) registry.
- 4. Wait for a Match: Due to the genetic complexity of matching donors to patients, it may take several months or even years before you're matched with a patient in need.
- 5. Donate: If you're a match, you'll be contacted. Most donations involve no surgery at all—similar to donating plasma. The process typically takes a few hours over a few weeks. Donating is safe and doesn't impact your ability to have children.

Thank you for considering becoming a bone marrow donor and making a difference in someone's life!
