SHAKE THESE BONES takes place in New York City as the renowned Gibney Dance Company doubles its ensemble size to prepare for a World Premiere Program at the Joyce Theater featuring not one but three works by celebrated choreographers, TONY® Award winner Sonya Tayeh, Alan Lucien Øyen, and Rena Butler.

The documentary spans the Company's journey through the pandemic to opening night, soaring from its innate sensitivity to beauty and exceptional talent on screen and on the film crew. Directed by Olga Lvoff (BUSY INSIDE) with cinematography by Daniel Kharlak, **SHAKE THESE BONES** showcases the unique world of Gibney Company's artists: different in backgrounds, races, and ages—yet all bold individuals with a passionate devotion to dance and a desire to give back through social justice causes.

Bethany Menzies, **SHAKE THESE BONES** Executive Producer, originated the genesis for a documentary about Gibney Company at a cultural milestone and threshold, and approached filmmaker, Amy Sewell (MAD HOT BALLROOM). Backing was secured by January 2020 and production with the immersive participation by the Reel Works Junior Workforce, led

by The Studio @ Reel Works Founder and Executive Director Stephanie Troise Walter began in February. Two weeks later, NYC was on lockdown.

Richly conceived and respectful, **SHAKE THESE BONES** is a shimmering ode to the fine arts—dance and cinema in particular—to New York City, and to abiding intention. Viewers of all ages will have a VIP backstage pass, and take inspiration from the electric grit and wondrous virtuosity of each dancer. The film offers a rare chance to experience extraordinary lives, and poignant assurance.

SHAKE THESE BONES generates introspection and crucial conversations about what is meaningful in life to individuals and society writ large. Get ready for some fun fandom and 'Dance in Film' lists, too.
